

Cannabis Policy 101

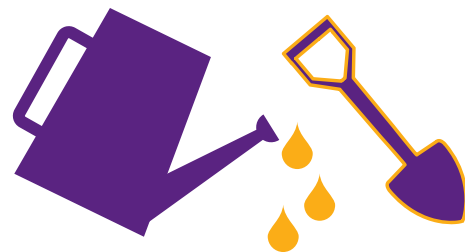
Effective October 17, 2018, recreational cannabis will become legal in Canada. Capital Region Housing has developed a new policy that outlines the rules regarding smoking or vaping legalized cannabis.

Smoking or vaping cannabis



Smoking or vaping **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED** in or around all CRH properties unless there is a designated CRH smoking area available.

Growing cannabis plants



Growing cannabis plants **WILL BE ALLOWED**. Tenants are required to follow all Canadian and provincial laws and all City of Edmonton by-laws related to growing and keeping cannabis.



Using cannabis in vehicles

Under provincial law, cannabis use of any kind **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED** in a motor vehicle, even if the vehicle is parked.

No Smoking - March 1, 2019

Effective March 1, 2019, tenants will **NOT BE ALLOWED** to smoke, burn or vape tobacco, cannabis, incense or other substances anywhere on Capital Region Housing property. This includes inside private units or on balconies, in common areas within buildings, parking lots and outdoor areas of the property, unless there is a designated smoking area indicated.
